The sudden end to our Good News Clubs this year was difficult and challenging. I became very concerned for our children who live in homes where often the caregivers were not loving and kind. I began to pray for God's protection for these little ones. I called all of the homes speaking with the parents and let them know I was praying for them and if they needed help to please call me. Many were very happy for my call and some shared with me how difficult this time was for them as they had to school their children at home.

I wanted to keep in touch with the children so I sent each one a letter with coloring pages to remind them of the lessons we just learn about. As I looked back at the lessons we had been teaching the past weeks, it was clear to me God had been preparing the children for such a time as this. God knew what lessons the children would need to hear. In the letter I reminded them how God took care of Esther and His people. Even when Esther did not know what was going to happen, she trusted God and they can trust God because He is Sovereign. That means He is in control of everything.

Our last Bible lesson in Good News Club was when the Disciples were in a boat and a great storm came up. They were afraid of the storm. The Disciples did not need to be afraid because Jesus was in the boat with them. With just His words, "Peace be still", Jesus stopped the storm.

I told them, like Esther, you may not understand why this bad thing is happening, but remember, like the Disciples, Jesus is with you and He will take care of you.

Two Hispanic boys in my Club had each been working to earn a special Bible. I was able to drop them off and the children were so happy to see me and to get the new Bibles. The teenage girl who comes to Club with her brothers and younger sister told me they were studying the Bible together as a family. God knew how important these Bibles were to this family.

As I prepare for the summer Missionary work, I am excited to see what God has planned for the children in 5-Day Clubs. Please be in prayer for the five teens who will serve with me this summer. We do not know what lies ahead, but God knows.
