Luke 10:2 and Our Summer Ministries

"The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He would send forth labourers into His harvest."

In the fall of 2018, the Lord put on the hearts of CEF USA leadership to implement Luke 10:2 in the strategic planning for the future of this ministry. Prayer is of utmost importance to inspire more workers to spread the Gospel and teach our children Biblical truths.

We are thankful for our existing workers here in central Ohio, but we need to earnestly pray that more workers would be willing to take on this vital ministry to children. This summer we were privileged to take the Gospel to local children during 5-Day Clubs, fairs and festivals. Our Ministry Coordinator Laura Gardner worked with our Christian Youth In Action teens, including team leaders Elise Herman and Xander Weidner, along with Samantha Castle, Allie Copeland, Kayla Herman, Michael Herman, Lucas Justice, and Lillian Lagerstam. Following are some testimonies and pictures from our summer work during 5-Day Clubs.



"I've Got the Word of God!!!"

Little 6-year-old Corbin gave his heart to Jesus on July 18, 2019. Allie Copeland, one of our summer missionaries, led him to Christ. When she asked him if he had a Bible, he said no, and Allie told him we would get one for him. He was disappointed that he had to wait. Allie told me how much he wanted a Bible. I remembered I had a little New Testament in my van, so I gave it to Corbin. He was so excited that he exclaimed, "I've got the word of God, I'VE GOT THE WORD OF GOD!!!" as he held it up and then began lovingly looking at the pages. It touched my heart that a little 6-year-old boy, who couldn't even read yet, was excited about having God's Word. Then the next day we gave Corbin and the other children a whole Bible. He was just as excited as the day before as he began to look at the words on the pages.

On the last day of club, I found out that Corbin's dad had been arrested that week and was in jail. His 5-year-old sister Millie had been coming back for counseling but she was always distracted and did not seem to have a clear understanding of the Gospel. I asked Millie if there was anything I could pray

I prayed for Millie and Corbin's dad. Allie walked Millie and Corbin home and was praying with their mother when Corbin came back over to me, Bible in hand and looking up at me with eyes that pierced my soul, and asked, "Where are you going?" I told him we had to leave now, but he now had Jesus to watch over him. I didn't want to leave. Thankfully the church that sponsored this 5-Day Club, Crossroads CCC in Circleville, will be following up on Corbin and Millie's family as they have an outreach to their community.

It is very important that we get out of our churches and share the Gospel so children like Corbin and Millie can hear about Jesus. I am thankful for the eight teenagers who gave up much of their summer to share Christ with 203 children and for the 19 salvations. I also would like to thank those who donated snacks for the children and money to feed them lunch this summer. Not only were they hungry for the Gospel but many of the communities we go into are poor and because of your generosity we were able to feed 100 children. I would also like to thank Crossroads CCC for providing lunch for our team during the week we were in Circleville. A special thank you to Matt Capsel for cooking for us every day. The food was delicious.
