One young woman who was a member of one of their churches stopped by to share the joy she'd found in Christ after being delivered from drugs. She had removed earrings from all over her face and tongue in order to glorify the Lord and eagerly told others about Him.

We had a drawing for an ice cream cake. When we called the winner, we were amazed that the dad remembered Ray sharing the gospel with his 4th grade son and was grateful. Two of our trained CYIA teens were a wonderful help with Laura Gardner, engaging with children and sharing the gospel with them. Their heart for reaching others is a blessing to see. Thank you, Allie and Lucas! Thank you to Jim, as well, one of our Good News Club teachers, who was a pied piper, inviting children on the grounds to visit our booth.

COVID-19 had its effects. For the first time in many years, the number of teens from all over the state attending CYIA summer training was down. In Columbus, we usually have eight or so 5 Day Clubs in backyards. But we didn't even have a team to serve. Not to be discouraged, Lucas (who was previously trained), volunteered his family's home and ran a whole Club with a group of children. If you know teens of this caliber, with a heart to serve, CYIA is an invaluable resource to recommend to them. By God's grace, doors will be open next year.

More Training in Columbus by Laura Gardner

Sandy Harper and I held a Super Seminar training in August for Project Reset. Reset is a Christian organization partnering with Columbus Public Schools to share the Gospel with children during the school day. Children are released from the school building to attend one hour of Bible instruction and then return to school for the rest of the day.



Sandy and I trained seven of their workers on how to effectively share the Gospel, how to lead a child to Christ, teaching children memory verses, as well as other topics.

One young man who was there told me he works 16-hour days and was tired but was very glad he chose to come. He said he learned so much and that he will be using what he learned in all the teaching he does not only with Reset but as a youth leader in his church.
